Tabard is indicated for the control (repellent) of house flies, stable flies and mosquitoes on horses.

From the case study by Veterinary Surgeon Dr. Glynn Catton - "Conducting Insect Challenge Repellency / Efficacy Trials" - presented at the South African Equine Veterinary Association Congress 2016:

- Research indicates that the active ingredient, DEET* interferes with receptors in biting insects such as mosquito antennae, that detect L-lactic acid and carbon dioxide - the primary attractants emitted by humans and animals
- Insects exposed to DEET* are therefore unable to effectively locate a host
- DEET was originally developed by the US Army for protection of military personnel and was later registered for public use. A Standard was established by the US EPA in 1980 and DEET was re-registered in 1998 following a review and additional animal and avian toxicity data in the same year

Read instructions and warnings on labels carefully and only use the product as directed:

- Apply lotion directly to affected areas.
- Apply lightly, evenly and completely to all exposed skin, except eyes and mouth.

Thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application, to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until the horse's coat is dry before applying Tabard Equine Lotion. Wear a rubber glove or mitt when applying the product, while working against the lay of the coat to ensure adequate coverage.

Tabard Equine Lotion can be applied once daily in undiluted form by wiping on to horses with a clean muslin cloth, sponge or grooming brush - utilising approximately 180ml to treat an entire horse. Avoid getting lotion into the horse's eyes, nose or mouth.

Should a horse show any form of skin irritation, discontinue use, seek veterinary advice and notify the registration holder.
